- **State Project:** Tuberculosis sanitoriums located in Clinton and Talihina. The amount voted for Clinton was held over to the next year. Purchased electrocardiograph machine, 38 card tables, and chairs for Talihina in the amount of \$997.96. Kits sent to patients for the year amounted to \$1,023.88 in monetary value.
