By-law Amendments:

- It was voted that any chapter not paying state dues for 3 years would not receive a complimentary copy of the "Petticoat Journal". The chapter could be reinstated by paying the current years dues.
- Awards Chairman was added to the Executive Board.
- It was agreed that the Oklahoma State Council meetings be held in the Metropolitan Oklahoma City area because of its central location.
- It was recommended by the Sooner Seniorettes that the Oklahoma State Council By-laws be revised and presented at the next State Convention.
- Chapters were requested to submit monthly articles for Petticoat Journal, not to exceed 1/4 page.
- Motion was made and carried that monies in the Oklahoma Home Board be contributed to the IC Disaster Fund. Home Board Members Lucille Turner and Betty Andrews to be retained another year until monies have been disbursed.
- Philanthropic: 101 Chapters reported 705 hours of service and contributed \$36,751.38 in money and monetary gifts.
- State Project: Oklahoma School for the Blind at Muskogee and Jane Brooks School for the Deaf at Chickasha. 69 Chapters contributed 3,667 hours; \$2,346163 to Project Fund and \$6,809.93 in money and monetary gifts, for a total of \$9,156.56. With a \$1,200.00 allocation to each school, purchases were a commercial dishwasher for Jane Brooks and furniture for Dorm B-4 at the Oklahoma School for the Blind.
