SPECIAL NOTES:

- **By-law Amendments:**
 - It was voted that the State Parliamentarian be an elected office. She shall advise on parliamentary procedure and be chairman of the By-laws Committee. State divided into 7 districts according to counties.
 - President of Sooner Seniorettes to be the only member to attend State Executive Board meetings.
- **State Project:** Oklahoma School for the Blind at Muskogee and Jane Brooks School for the Deaf at Chickasha. 88 Chapters contributed 3,998 1/4 hours; \$3,199.50 to Project Fund; \$10,997.57 in money and monetary gifts, for a total of \$14,097.07. Allocation for each school was \$1,100 and purchases were: 38 sets of drapes for B-4 dorm for the Oklahoma School for the Blind and Zenith auditory training equipment for Jane Brooks School for the Deaf.
- **Philanthropic:** 100 Chapters reported 27,693 1/2 hours of service, total monies of \$30,662.74, and monetary value of \$18,874.63, for a total of \$49,537.37.
- **POW-MIA Chairman, Korean War:** Maxine Beaver reported Oklahoma sent 53,000 signed letters for release of prisoners of war/missing in action personnel in Korean War.
- **Disaster Fund:** 85 Chapters and one City Council contributed \$780.58.

- Educational: 472 reports received from 81 chapters, 43 Gold Link Awards, 22 entries for Gold Seal, and 7 entries for Distinguished Athenian Service Award. won by Sharon Bourassa, Beta Nu #3181, Oklahoma City.
- Home Board: Betty Andrews and Lucille Turner reported Oklahoma had \$6,982.05 returned to our state. Motion was made and carried that Oklahoma divide the money equally and give to IC Disaster Fund and World Center Foundation.
