- **By-law Amendments:**
 - Dues increased to \$25.00 per Chapter.
 - Added correct name for all Bank Accounts.
 - Jr. Past President to be Chairman of the Nominating Committee and to prepare ballots for Credentials Chairman.
 - Changed terms for serving for First Vice President to add one term as Senior Past President.
 - Chairman may not serve more than one year except Bike Ride and World Center Foundation Counselor, who may serve 2 year terms.
 - Disaster Chairman to submit monthly report to IC Disaster Fund Chairman with copy to President.

- **Disaster Fund:** \$1,356.40 contributed - 1 claim filed. \$2,598.27.

- **Philanthropic:** 100 Chapters reported total hours of service 39,912 3/4 and total monies, \$123,279.81.

- **Bike Rides:** 19 Bike Rides and other events raised \$36,624.98

- **Educationals:** 113 Chapters reported 702 reports; 75 Gold Links presented; 21 Gold Seal entries; 17 DASA entries - winner, Wilma Schwenker, Epsilon Kappa #1945, Hominy

- **Sweetheart Pledge:** 16 entries - winner, Martha Ward, Delta Pi, OK City

- **DIANA Winner:** Lottie Marie Reese nominated by Delta Beta, Claremore

- **World Center Foundation:** 44 Chapters participated in presenting the BSE program and were responsible for 31,284 women in Oklahoma knowing about the program. \$1,202.71 contributed by members.

- Leadership Seminar: Held Sept. 14, 1975; Mike Burns of Hdq., Guest Speaker; 226 members attended.
- State Project: Okla.School for the Blind at Muskogee and Jane Brooks School at Chickasha. 92 Chapters contributed 3,324 1/2 hours of service; Project Fund \$5,261.20; Money and Monetary Gifts \$14,744.65 for total of \$20,005.85. Each school allocated \$2,500 and purchases were: OSB -two auto. bowling pin spotters, Units A-1 and B-1 recreation room improvements; for Jane Brooks - 6 elec.typewriters, tables and book stands.
